# PAYMENT

# **RESEARCH PROJECT SUBMISSION SPECIFICATIONS**

In the registration form, include the payment receipt obtained during the payment confirmation, personal and academic details, submission category, research area, and a research abstract. The abstract should not exceed 300 words or 2000 characters, excluding the title, authors, and keywords. The abstract must include the following sections: introduction, objective, method, results, and conclusion. For research proposals, only the expected results should be included after the method.

- **Title:** (Maximum 15 words or 150 characters). The title should briefly and clearly convey the main idea of the protocol or completed research project.
- Authors: List the full names of the main author followed by the co-authors. A total of 300 characters is available for author names (e.g., Juan Antonio Pérez López; Juan A. Pérez-López; Juan Pérez, J.A. Pérez-López; J. Pérez-López; J. Pérez). Project advisors should be included as authors.
- Introduction: Provide relevant background information and context that gives rise to the research question.
- **Objective:** Clearly state the purpose of the work.
- Method: Describe the population or object of study, procedures, and instruments used to collect data (it can include study design, participants, materials, and instruments).
- **Results:** Describe the findings obtained or expected in a written format (not in figures or tables).
- **Conclusion:** Relate the results to the objective, link them to findings from similar studies, and highlight the contribution to the relevant area of knowledge.
- Keywords: 3 to 5, separated by commas.

Certificates and conference proceedings will be generated based on the data provided in the registration. All authors should carefully review the spelling and accuracy of the required data before submission. Any modification requests after submission will incur an additional fee of \$100.00 (MXN) Mexican pesos.

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# ABSTRACT EVALUATION

CRITERIA

AWARDS

Submitted projects will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee, considering the quality of content and adherence to the stipulated guidelines. The Committee will decide on the acceptance or rejection of each abstract. The decision of the Scientific Committee is final and will be communicated via the email provided in the registration form. Only submissions that receive an acceptance letter will be allowed to participate.

### **VISUAL PRESENTATION**

A title that is engaging, relevant to the research content, and aligns with the guidelines. Correct spelling and grammar. Design and colors that enhance readability.

#### PRESENTATION DELIVERY

Clarity in explaining the research (using appropriate language). Demonstrated knowledge of the research topics.

Effective use of the presentation as a support tool, rather than reading from it.

The abstract should include the following sections in a clear and concise manner: title, introduction, objective, material and method, results or expected results, and conclusions for completed projects. Information should be sufficient, organized, clear, and coherent.

CONTENT

#### DEFENSE

Clear, coherent, and well-supported responses to judges' questions.

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Digital certificates will be awarded to the top three research projects in each category and academic level for both in-person and virtual presentations. Winners will receive an electronic diploma as a special distinction based on their ranking.



## **IN-PERSON RESEARCH PRESENTATION**

Research should be presented in poster format to facilitate open discussion on theoretical, methodological, and empirical aspects. Authors should be present at the scheduled time to provide explanations and answer questions from attendees and judges. The schedule and locations will be published in the program via social media and sent to the email provided during registration (See Appendix 1).


### Printed Poster Specifications

- Printed on bond paper, with dimensions of **90 cm wide by 120** cm high.
- Use text fonts that are readable from a meter away, avoid text overload, and use high-resolution images to support the explanation of the research. Choose colors that enhance readability and image visibility.

### VIRTUAL RESEARCH PRESENTATION

The virtual presentation consists of a 10-minute session per submission, including 5 minutes for the presentation and 5 minutes for questions (See Appendix 2).

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# Appendix I. Content of the In-Person Presentation



### **Category | Research Project**

**Header:** Place the research title (maximum 15 words) at the top of the poster, along with the full names of each author and the details and/or logos of their affiliated institution. **Introduction:** Briefly present the theoretical or empirical data that contextualize the research, highlighting the problem that justifies the study.

**Objective:** Describe in a single sentence what the research aims to achieve. **Method:** It is recommended to describe some of the following elements

- Participants
- Materials
- Instruments
- **Procedure**
- Study Design

The inclusion or exclusion of these elements may be adjusted according to the type or design of the research being conducted (descriptive, correlational, explanatory, etc.).

**Expected Results**: This section aims for the authors to mention the expectations they have of the study they will conduct regarding empirical, methodological, and theoretical aspects.

**References:** Present the scientific sources consulted, following the APA 7th edition format.

### Category | Completed Research projects

For completed research projects, all the elements mentioned above are required, except for the Expected Results section. Instead, the following should be included:

**Results:** Present the most relevant research findings using graphs and/or tables. It is recommended that they have a good resolution and size, making them easy to read. Each graph and/or table should have a title indicating the information it represents.

**Discussion/Conclusion:** Relate the results to the research objective, link them to findings from similar studies, and highlight the contribution of the research to the relevant area of knowledge.





# Appendix 2. Content of the Virtual Presentation

### **Content Characteristics of the Video**

**Cover:** Include the research title (maximum 15 words) and the full names of each author, along with the details or logos of their affiliated institution (do not include the IICAN logo unless you are an active student of this institution).

**Introduction:** Briefly present the background, empirical evidence, and models or theories that support the research, clearly stating the problem and justification for the study.

**Objective:** Describe in a single sentence what the research aims to achieve.

**Method:** Describe the study design, participants, sample and sampling methods (for quantitative studies), materials, instruments, and procedures.

**Results** (Expected Results and/or Comments): Describe the most relevant research findings. For research protocols, include the expected results. The presentation can include tables or figures, following APA 7th edition format (make sure they have a good resolution and size for easy readability).

**Discussion/Conclusion:** Mention the main findings of the research and highlight the contribution to the relevant area of knowledge (omit this section if it is a research protocol).
